What to Bring

1. Shirts **with sleeves** to work in for two days

** Please do not wear sleeveless shirts on the worksite.*

2. ****Long pants** & Closed-toe shoes/boots**

** Any and all open-toed footwear will not be allowed on the worksite*

- ↪ Hammers/ Drills
- ↪ Casual clothes (*when not on the worksite*)
- ↪ Bedding linens, sleeping bag, pillow
- ↪ **Single Air Mattress/Cot**(**very important for space**)
- ↪ Sunscreen
- ↪ Paintbrush
- ↪ Pajamas/ Sleep wear
- ↪ Towel, wash cloth
- ↪ Toiletry items
- ↪ Insect Repellant

Recommended to Bring

- ↪ Sunglasses
- ↪ Backpack/bag to carry tools/water bottle to the site
- ↪ Hat
- ↪ Snacks

What Not to Bring

- ↪ Inappropriate clothing (includes offensive or inappropriate slogans/designs, revealing clothing or anything else deemed inappropriate by the WOC staff or your Youth Director)
- ↪ Firearms, alcohol, drugs, or fireworks
- ↪ Anything that you don't want broken, stolen, or lost!

** for safety reasons*

For Adults:

- ↪ Please bring any tools you think might be needed on the worksite.
- WOC has a limited number of tools to loan.
- ↪ One ice chest & one water cooler
- ↪ Basic first aid supplies
