The Weekend of the Cross planning team looks forward to providing a safe, fun, and memorable mission trip experience. Each participant is responsible for acting in a way that is respectful to God, themselves, and others.

- Weekend of the Cross provides dormitory sleeping arrangements in which at least 2 unrelated adults will be assigned to sleep in each room.
- Proper attire must be worn at all times with no exceptions. T-Shirts with suggestive slogans, low cut shirts, midriff exposure, short shorts, shirts, skirts, or see through clothing are not allowed.
- Behavior of participants must reflect that of a good Christian role model.
- Inappropriate physical contact with anyone is not allowed. (No PDA)

To Provide the Best Experience, All WOC Participants Agree to The Following:

Expected Behavior

- Be respectful of others and property.
- Be responsible for your words and actions.
- Dress and behave modestly to show respect to God, other participants, the community, and its people.
- Follow the designated schedule especially for meals, worship, shower times, scheduled lights out, room assignments, and quiet times.
- Attend and participate at worksites and worship services.
- Do not use cell phones, gaming devices, or anything else causing a distraction on work sites or during worship programs and understand there is no security for valuables.
- Follow directions from adult leaders, other adult participants, WOC staff, and host church representatives.
- Be alert to potential safety risks and take action to prevent injury to other participants and yourself.

Prohibited Behavior

- Endangering the health and safety of yourself, other participants, residents, partners, staff, or volunteers.
- Entering areas of the host church site that are not assigned to you.
- Leaving the worksite without permission.
- Leaving the lodging/host church facility once you are check-in until WOC dismissal.
- Damaging of any property.
- Using profanity, inappropriate language, or displaying clothing or other personal items with offensive content.
- Inappropriate physical contact, comments, gestures, references, pictures, or videos.
- Illegal activity, possession, or use of alcohol, illegal drugs, firearms, weapons, or any object that may cause harm to another or place another person in fear of their safety.
- Use tobacco, e-cigarettes, or vape pens in vehicles, church grounds, or project site.
- Bullying, violence, acts of aggression, discrimination, or language that is attacking or degrading toward any other person.

I understand that I am a guest to the host church property and will be respectful to the facilities. Any damage to host church property is the liability of the person involved and/or the parent of the minor involved. I understand that failure to comply with this code of conduct may result in a trip home at my/my parent's expense.
